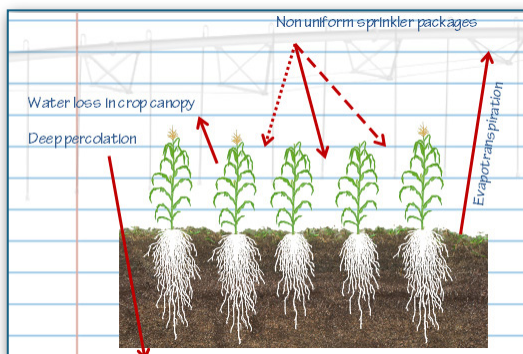


Learn the Basics of Irrigation Scheduling
