■ Straight Non-Tapered

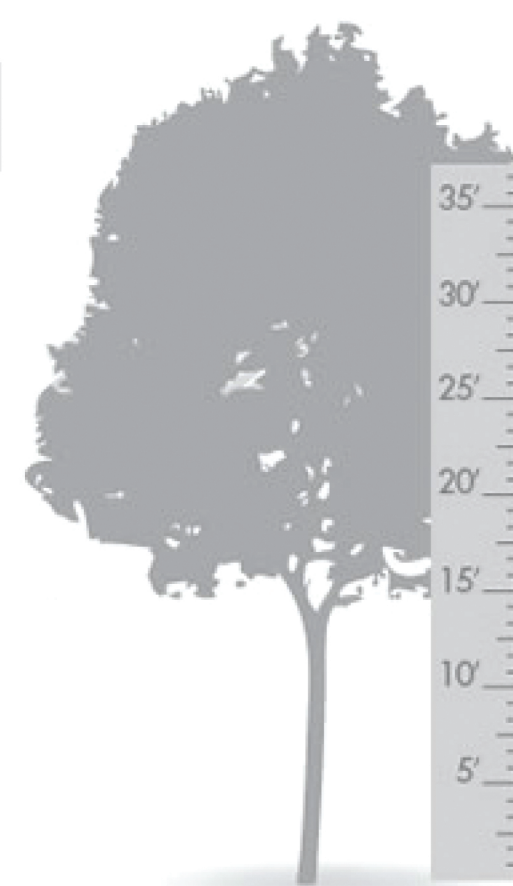


Petite visual scaling

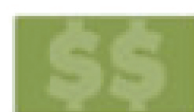
